

Bricco dei Tati Estate

Bricco Dei Tati is a small, family-owned wine estate in the heart of the Lange region of Piemonte, Italy. The estate covers just a little more than three acres on a hillside across the valley from the village of Barbaresco. The majority of the vines are now 80 years old. It's a spectacular place, rich in beauty and tradition. The estate has been managed and cultivated fully organic and sustainable for the last fifty years.

Grape Varietals ෂ Vinification Technique

100% Dolcetto grapes come from 80 year old vines that grow on the southwest side of our hill in Piemonte. It is bottled unfiltered and unrefined. Some sediment should be expected. Aged in used (neutral) barrique for 8 to 12 months. Rich with lively tannins, this wine shows the Dolcetto grape at its best. We produced only approximately 3400 bottles each vintage. THis wine is best after 5 to 6 years of aging to reach its full profile.

Suggested Food Pairing

Perfect with pasta dishes, risotto and stews. Also wonderful with cheeseburgers and pizza.
